- Criminal background check form (1 per parent or guardian)
- Student Application (middle school only)
- Registration fees - \$200.00 (per student/non-refundable)

- Application
- Birth certificate copy (Kindergarten only)
- Immunization card
- Records transfer request (grades 1-8)
- Registration card
- Society Membership Form and Fees-\$100.00/family (tax deductible)
- Criminal background check form (1 per parent or guardian)
- Student Application (Middle School only)
- Registration fees - \$225.00 (per student/non-refundable)

ALL PARENTS MUST ATTEND BACK TO SCHOOL ORIENTATION IN AUGUST
(If you are unable to attend, please schedule a meeting with the administrator to review school policies and procedures before the school year begins)

Tuition 2010/2011

*Full Day Kindergarten: \$3,700 or \$370/mo for 10 months

*Elementary: \$3,900 or \$390/mo for 10 months
(Grades 1-5)

*Middle School: \$4,200 or \$420/mo for 10 months
(Grades 6-8)

Discounts: 5% if tuition is paid in full before September 1, 2010. 5% multiple student discount for families with two or more children.

Volunteer 30 hours or \$300: The volunteer requirement is not included in the tuition. Families will be billed for hours not served. Volunteer time completed must be logged in the yellow notebook in the office. Fees paid in lieu of hours volunteered are tax deductible.
